Call to Order:

Approval of Minutes:

Secretary/Treasurer's Report: The TID received the money from the Commissioners' General Fund in the amount of \$400,000. The balance of the account is now \$600,000.

Project Updates

Graphics Way - Lifepoint Church:

Staff is continuing dialogue with the Lifepoint Church regarding the proposed special assessment and recovering any remaining project costs from TIF revenues available through the Slate Ridge, Creekside or other TIF's in the area. AEP previously declined to participate in the project through special assessment.

<u>Piatt-Roloson Road Extension - Berlin Station Road to Curve Road:</u>

DCEO has had conversations with John Pardi, representative of Longhill Limited Partnership, the Developer of a 295 acre, 400+ unit residential development north of Berlin Station Road regarding a 1.05 mile extension of Piatt Road and Roloson Road through the project as contemplated by the 2001 Delaware County Thoroughfare Plan.

As discussed the TID would undertake the project and the county commissioners would impose an agreed special assessment on the development lots to pay for the Developer's portion of the project, including construction and financing costs, which is currently estimated at up to \$2.5 million of the \$3.7 million total estimated project construction cost.

Homewood (Trinity Homes) owns an additional 62 acres which the road would pass through, and would also need to agree to the TID. Staff will be initiating conversation with Homewood on the special assessment proposal.

The TID and/or the County Commissioners would pay for the remaining share of the project construction cost which would be approximately \$1 million in an arrangement yet to be determined.
