Call to Order:

Monthly Report: Rob Riley

1. HOME ROAD EXTENSION, PHASE 2 & 3

Ohio EPA issued the last remaining permit for the project the week of 11/25. Savko is breaking ground the week of 12/9 on sanitary sewer construction as weather allows. DCEO is working with Savko to schedule construction activity to complete the section of Home Road from US 23 to the Orange Grand development by September as originally scheduled; however, it is likely that full completion of the road will be pushed to December 2020.

2. GRAPHICS WAY EXTENSION (LIFEPOINT CHURCH)

Staff is discussing the most efficient manner to bid and contract for this work and will have recommendation for the TID at the January 2020 meeting to proceed with traditional competitive bidding, solicitation of proposals from contractors already working in the area or reverse auctioning.

Construction would be expected to begin in May/June 2020 with completion by September 2020, coinciding with the completion of Graphics Way within the Slate Ridge development as part of the Home Road Extension project.

3. HYATTS ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

County Engineer and Regional Sewer District staff have discussed combining proposed roadway and sanitary sewer improvements at Hyatts Road and US 23 as a single project to be undertaken by the DCTID.

The roadway improvements include widening of Hyatts Road and Shanahan Road approaches to US 23 to provide for turn lanes, and includes replacement of culverts and constructing headwalls for a large 96-inch diameter pipe culvert under Hyatts Road just west of US 23 to allow for the widening.

The sanitary sewer improvements include constructing a new pump station west about 500 feet west of US 23 on the north side of Hyatts Road, and constructing gravity sewers to the east, passing under US

23 and serving the area from Shanahan Road to Peachblow Road east of US 23. Sewage would be pumped west to existing gravity sewers farther west on Hyatts Road, ultimately to the Olentangy Environmental Control Center (OECC) treatment plant.

Due to the location of the sanitary sewers passing under Hyatts Road, it is desirable to construct all of these improvements concurrently. Staff believes there will be considerable opportunity for cost savings to both the road and sanitary sewer construction by combining under a single contract, as well as less inconvenience to the travelling public by constructing both projects under the same road closure.

Total construction cost is estimated at approximately **\$6 million**. Staff would recommend to not require prevailing wage compliance as part of the bid.

Proposed project schedule would be as follows:

1/8/2020: DCTID board approval of plans, specifications, estimates and the project agreement with Delaware County Board of Commissioners

1/10/2020: Advertisement for bids

2/4/2020: Bid opening

2/12/2020: Contract award by DCTID

12/1/2020: Construction complete

4. RIVERBY ESTATES SUBDIVISION IMPROVEMENTS

Staff requests approval of a resolution to reschedule the public hearing to consider the Riverby Street Improvements project to **February 12, 2020** to allow additional time to complete the estimated schedule of assessments and notification of property owners.

Construction schedule of the project would not be impacted. Construction would be completed by June 2020.
